

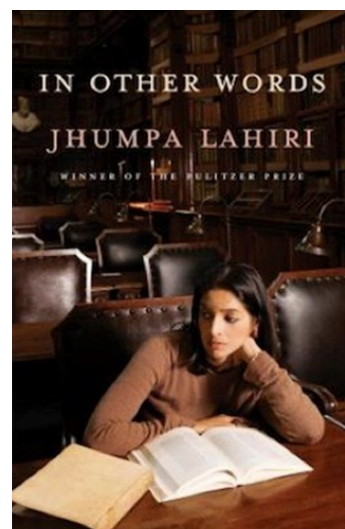

Pulitzer Prize winning author Jhumpa Lahiri writes in her first book in Italian, *In altre parole* (2015; *In Other Words*), “When you’re in love, you want to live forever. Because every day there will be a new word to learn. Thus true love can represent eternity.**”
